However, I will still be recording sermons and making these available on our website, and I or an elder will be available for private communion. Also you may feel free to come by the church and receive communion.

During this time, the office staff will still be available and will continue to monitor phones and email, so if you need anything, please do not hesitate to contact the office or your elder. Please remember that your giving to our church will help us keep the business of the church going. To that end I encourage you to continue giving your offerings. You can do this by mailing in or bringing your envelopes to the office. The Give Plus option is also available if you would like to give online and we would be happy to help with setting that up.

We are keeping a close eye on things as they develop and will post updates as they become available.

We know this is upsetting news in a difficult time and our prayers go out to our community, yet I encourage you to take heart and remember the grace that is ours in Christ. Hear the words of the Psalmist "God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear though the earth gives way."
